

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT: WHAT AND HOW?

Community engagement = authentically involving the people you and your organization hope to serve in planning and decision-making about your work.

How to Get There?

- Meet people where they are; find out what the community needs
- Ask questions before providing solutions
- Listen, listen and help communities access resources to meet their goals
- Work to build relationships of trust



Community members initiate actions independently of external institutions

Participation is seen as a right/ responsibility. There is joint analysis and decision-making. Community members have a stake in maintaining the project.

Community members are invited to participate because of external mandates; some shared decision-making on minor issues.

Community members participate by answering questions, filling out surveys, and providing other information.

Community members participate as recipients of information and are told what has already been decided.

Community members sit on committees but have no real power.
