

DIRECTIONS TO COLERAIN

FROM NORTH OF THE CHOWAN RIVER

Travel US 13 South to the intersection of NC 45 at Winton. Turn left onto NC 45 South. Travel 18 miles to the only traffic signal in Colerain. Continue through the small business district and turn right onto Academy Street. The community building will be on your right.

FROM EAST OF THE CHOWAN RIVER

Travel US 17 South to the intersection of NC 45 at Midway (between Edenton and Windsor). Turn right onto NC 45 North. Colerain is 13 miles from US 17. As soon as you enter Colerain Town Limit turn left onto Academy Street. The community building will be on your right.

FROM WEST OF THE CHOWAN RIVER USING US 17

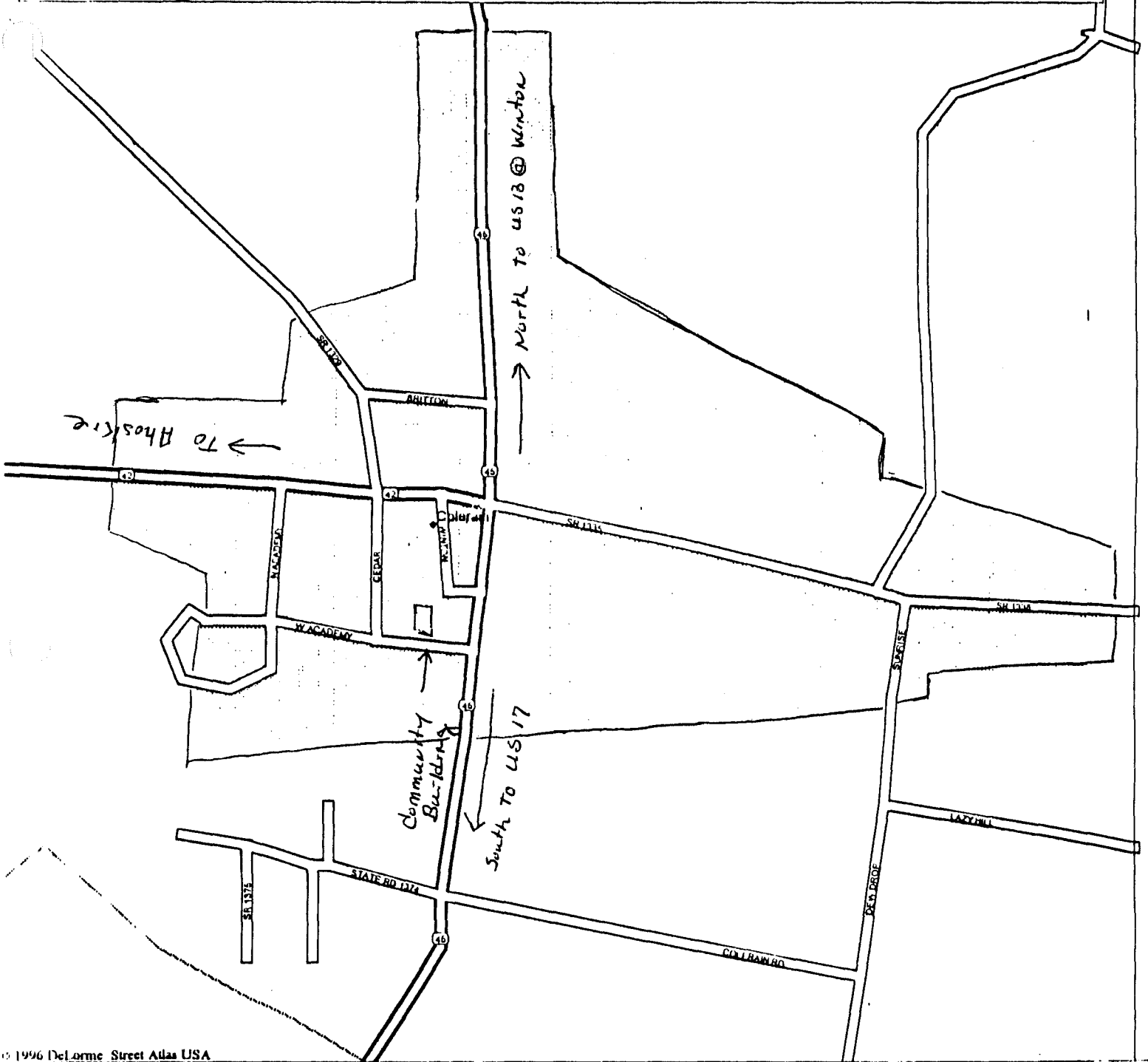
Travel US 17 North to the intersection of NC 45 at Midway (between Windsor and Edenton). Turn left onto NC 45 North. Colerain is 13 miles from US 17. As soon as you enter Colerain Town Limit turn left onto Academy Street. The community building will be on your right.

FROM WEST OF THE CHOWAN RIVER USING NC 42

Travel to Ahoskie and follow NC 42 East to the only traffic signal in Colerain. Turn right and continue through the small business district and turn right onto Academy Street. The community building will be on your right.

They also see the need for monitoring information, as Virginia has no good baseline data. The group would also like to bring in other stakeholders through a large workshop.
